- One Cluj (Un Singur Cluj) is a collaboration platform gathering 150 local organisations from the fields of culture and events, in support of the local hospitals and the public administration. One Cluj donated and facilitated more than 1,5 million protection equipment, 20 ventilators, 10 t of food and water for medical staff, hotel accommodation for 100 doctors, delivered 10 major logistic interventions and raised 250.000 euro for 40 medical units in the Cluj county. www.unsingurcluj.ro
